This free app, created by OverDrive, is available for Android, iOS (iPhone/iPad/iPod touch), and Windows 10 devices.

- Install the Libby app from your device's app store.
- Open the app and find your library. You can search by library name, city, or zip code.
- Browse your library's collection and borrow a title. When prompted, signin. You'll need a valid library card to complete this step.
- Borrowed titles appear on your Shelf and download to the app automatically so you can read them when you're offline.

From your Shelf, you can:

Tap Start Reading or Start Listening to open a title.
